EVENT	STANDARD	MAKE UP CREDIT	NOTES
Hockey Tourney	Work a minimum of one shift (either date)*	1 make up credit for each shift worked	
Golf Tourney	Elective opportunity to work event. Members strongly encouraged to participate.	None. (Standard credit received for day-of-event involvement; if missed, routine make up is encouraged.)	No make ups available as the activity replaces the weekly meeting.
Corn Booth	Work 2 (4 hour) shifts*	1 make up credit per shift worked.	If you bring along one or more non-Rotarians to assist your shift, then only 1 shift is required. (Make up still limited to 1.)
Bell Ringing	Work 1 shift*	1 make up credit per each shift worked	
EHS Community Service Student Recognition Dinner	Elective service opportunity	1 make-up credit	
Senior Lunch	Treated as normal meeting (despite different location).	None	No make up available as the activity replaces the weekly meeting.
Board Meetings	Regular attendance by board members	1 make up credit per board meeting	Secretary (or designee) responsible for reporting make up credits
Committee Meetings <i>(those not connected with regular Wednesday Club meetings)</i>	Regular attendance by committee members (golf, hockey, corn, etc.).	1 make up credit per committee meeting attended	Respective committee chair (or designee) are responsible for submitting make up data to Secretary.
District Training, Meetings	Attendance at function	1 make up credit per meeting attended
